

# Upgrade Server to latest Ubuntu version

```
sudo apt update && sudo apt full-upgrade -y
# needs reboot after update and before upgrade
sudo reboot

do-release-upgrade

# If you continue, an additional ssh daemon will be started at port '1022'.
